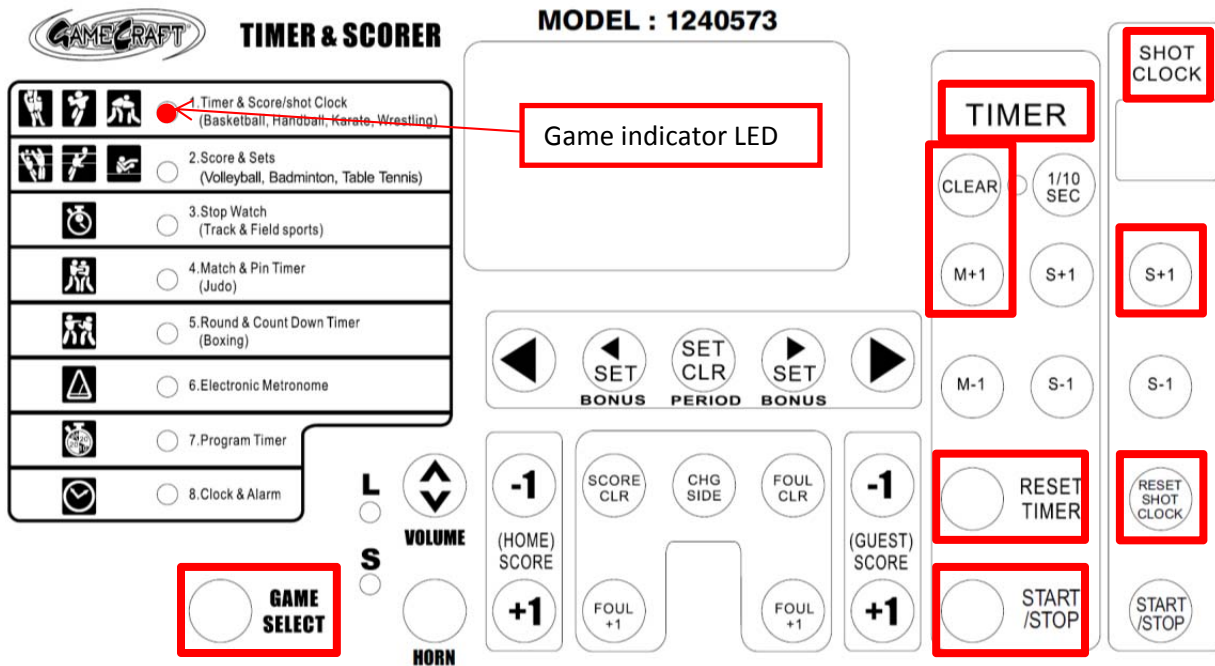


Procedure to set the period time (7:00 minutes) and shot clock interval (35 seconds) on portable scoring systems used by GHSWPA. System user panel shown below. Red frames locate key panel areas and buttons used in the procedure. MacGregor and GameCraft score boards use a common user panel and clock setting procedure.



1. Press "Game Select" repeatedly to cycle the game indicator LED all the way through the list and back to position 1 (make sure it is <i>not</i> blinking)		GAME SELECT
2. In the "Timer" section of the key panel, press CLEAR to erase timer settings		CLEAR
3. In the "Timer" section of the key panel, use M+ to set 7:00 minutes on the game clock		M+1
4. In the "Shot Clock" section of the key panel, use S+ to set 35 on the shot clock		S+1
5. In the "Timer" section of the key panel, press START/STOP to memorize the settings; the clocks should start counting down.		START /STOP
6. Press START/STOP again to stop the clocks.		START /STOP
7. Press RESET TIMER; game clock should reset to 7:00		RESET TIMER
8. Press "RESET SHOTCLOCK"; shot clock should reset to 35		RESET SHOT CLOCK
If either clock doesn't display correct time after steps 7 or repeat, start again with step 1. If they do show the correct time, then the clocks are ready.
